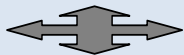
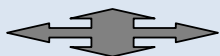

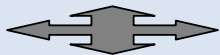

Type of Aid: Scholarship to Accredited Institution of Higher Education

CEPSCI Recertification Process

Prior to the expiration date shown on CEPSCI identification cards, Certified Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Inspectors are required by SC DHEC to complete DHEC approved professional development training in order to be recertified.

- Recertification does not require testing for any CEPSCI personnel who complete the approved training prior to his/her certification's expiration date.
- Recertification is not permitted by persons who are not currently certified.

For persons not currently CEPSCI certified, see the CEPSCI Initial Certification page for additional information about this process.

Please recognize that any person who conducts an inspection without current certification, as well as any site inspected, is in violation of state requirements and may be subject to enforcement actions.
